WHAT'S NEW AROUND TOWN?

The new Mulpha Norwest sales office is under construction next to Central Park The Lakes, along Solent Circuit, and should be finished by end of July. The sales office at Bella Vista Waters will then be closed and eventually sold.

Did you know there is a new restaurant coming to Circa Retail? George's Gourmet Pizzeria will open on 5th June.



NORTH WEST RAIL LINK:

The project's first tunnel boring machine (TBM), Elizabeth, has completed about 4.4 km of tunnelling, breaking through into the Showground Station site on 26th May. Elizabeth will undergo maintenance within the station area over the coming weeks, while infrastructure that supports the TBM will be relocated from Bella Vista to Showground. Once this transition is complete, Elizabeth will restart tunnelling towards Castle Hill. The second TBM, Florence, has tunnelled about 3.7 km and has just passed under Victoria Avenue in Castle Hill. Once Florence breaks through into the Showground Station site, the remaining tunnelling infrastructure will be relocated from Bella Vista to Showground.

Tunnelling on the North West Rail Link is now more than one-third complete. The road works on Celebration Drive are continuing. These works include extending the second eastbound lane from Old Windsor Road to the Lexington Drive roundabout, localised widening, drainage works, building new kerb and gutters and line marking. While most work will be done during the day, some activities will take place out of hours to reduce the impact on local traffic.
