Eight-Year-Old Designs And Makes A Cardboard Pokémon Tretta Machine In Covid Lockdown

Several family groups in a unit complex decided to build a cardboard replica games and music arcade. This inspired one 8-year-old boy to design and build his own cardboard, replica Packemon Tretta Machine to go with the arcade. Over one morning he built his machine out of two cardboard boxes, cleverly including all features of the real thing.



The only real items are the plastic Tretta trading cards

which can be bought from games shops, and come as rewards for winning games played on the Tretta machines. His replica machine includes 2 powerful Pokémon pictures on top, copied from Pokémon scenes in real, electronic machines, a plastic spinner to choose the type of adventure you want to experience, imitation control buttons, Tretta card slots and a cardboard stick which can be pulled in and out to allow "winning" trading cards to be ejected.

At the bottom of the lower cardboard box, he even included a sloping base to help the cards to eject successfully. This masterpiece was designed and made by 8-year-old Master Warrior Zombie Killer Benjie Png, who currently lives in Singapore. He is the grandson of Ian & Sarah, who live in Haven.

Mulpha lodges DA for first stage of worldleading mixed-use sustainable precinct

Norwest developer Mulpha has lodged its development application (DA) for the first stage of its approved \$Ibillion masterplanned community, Norwest Quarter, a development set to lead and shape the national conversation on sustainable neighbourhoods, and the keystone of Mulpha's vision to transform Norwest into a vibrant lifestyle and economic town centre.

Located within 400 metres of the new Norwest Metro Station at 40 Solent Circuit, Norwest in Sydney's Hills District, the first stage of Norwest Quarter will include two residential apartment buildings, with a total of 196 apartments, and more than 3,500sqm of specially curated retail and commercial space including a full-floor commercial gym, fresh food grocer, medical services, and restaurants.

The slender residential towers with their small building footprints will allow for 70 percent of the site to be used for landscaping and amenity, setting a new benchmark in integrated urban design and community making. Gently sloping landscaped grounds with scattered shade trees will lead up the stairs at the entry of Norwest Quarter to an open-air plaza with retail and outdoor dining, a nature based, informal play area, an amphitheater for community

events, and other landscaped areas.

Leading architects Bates Smart and Smart Design Studio, together with award winning landscaping firm Aspect Studios, urban designers Terroir, and environmental sustainability firm Finding Infinity, have been appointed to work together to design and deliver an innovative, environmentally led development, rich in design, with a unique nature-driven biophilic ethos encapsulating the built form and vibrant public realms.
