

Meet the Residents

Meet Barry Pareezer, who found a new passion in writing after retirement.



Barry and his wife Narelle have been living in Bella Vista Waters for over 20 years and have always been active members of our local area. They were foundation members of Bella Vista Waters Community Association, now known as Norwest Community Association. Together with a small group of people, they helped set up and launch Bella Vista Probus Club, which has been operating for over ten years. Narelle has been a volunteer with the 'Friends of Bella Vista Farm' for more than 16 years, and Barry is the Social Secretary for the Castle Hill RSL Subbranch. Barry is also

one of our wonderful newsletter distributing volunteers.

Barry's military and law enforcement background, combined with many unique experiences along life's journey, helped him launch into becoming an author.

Inspiration for his first novel came while flying home from China and reading a newspaper article about China's onechild policy and especially farmers wanting only sons. This brought to mind a kidnapping he investigated many years earlier. After several hours, he formatted a plot for a story starting in China and ending in Australia. The story, called 'Operation Sunburnt Dragon' was not completed until after retirement. During the two Covid lockdown periods, he converted that story and self-published it as a screenplay.

In early 2019, Barry committed to writing a novel each year. That year he selfpublished 'Wiseman', and in 2020, he wrote and selfpublished 'Murder & Heartache.' This year he released the latest novel, 'All or Nothing.' All are crime and mystery stories with a twist and a touch of romance. They are available at Amazon.com.au.
